Loss of coral reefs to land reclamation have occurred along the southwest coast of the mainland and on several of the offshore southern islands. Increased sedimentation have affected the remaining reefs in two ways: (1) by causing a slow but steady reduction in live coral cover, and (2) by reducing the lower depth limit of coral growth on reef slopes.

In 1912, Joubin published a map of coral reefs that included the Gulf of Mexico (Fig. 1.3), but not until the 1950s was further research conducted on reefs in the southern Gulf. Smith (1954) utilized Joubin's (1912) map, Heilprin's (1890) work, and other unpublished sources and nautical charts (Table 1.1) to prepare an updated coral reef distribution map and list of coral species.

Coral cover was relatively high on southern Coral Sea reefs such as Cato and Wreck Reefs (approximately 40%), where fragile branching corals were common, but tended to be much lower on central and northern reefs, probably because of frequent cyclone disturbance.

ASSESSMENT OF CORAL REEF BIODIVERSITY IN

Coral reef distribution on the northern coast of Jamaica extends from Morant Point in the east to Negril in the west. On the southern coast, the reefs are more restricted, occurring mostly on the eastern part of the continental shelf near Old Harbour and Port Royal. Reefs on the southern coast outside this area are small with a patchy distribution.
