Fred Ray's "Shock Troops of the Confederacy, as the subtitle indicates, is primarily focused upon the "sharpshooter battalions" of the Army of Northern Virginia (in a Civil War context, "sharpshooter" was usually more akin to "skirmisher" than "sniper", although these specialized battalions also used innovative open order assault techniques, especially late in the war), but does not neglect their closest Union counterparts nor the sharpshooter battalions in Confederate armies in the West.
